The greater Moncton Santa Claus Parade will be held on Saturday, November 27, 2010 starting at 6:00 P.M. from Cameron and Main Streets. The Parade will continue east on Main Street to Champlain Street at Paul St.

**STANDARDS AND CONDITIONS**

All entries are subject to the acceptance or rejection of the Parade Committee. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and their decision will be final. Applications received must be fully completed, including the description of entry. Entries that do not conform to the application description on parade day will be rejected.

All entries must use Christmas lights on their floats and be decorated in keeping with the parade theme. TOW VEHICLES MUST BE DECORATED

**All entries must be a float, no decorated cars, vans, busses or trucks will be permitted. Commercial overtones are to be minimized.**

Maximum Height of any entry must not exceed 11 feet 6 inches from the ground up, including tow vehicle height (in order to get under the subway). Any entry exceeding this limitation will not be accepted. There will be no rerouting. There will be no exception.

There are to be absolutely **NO HANDOUTS OR GIVE AWAYS** from any entry either by persons on the float or marchers. This is a dangerous practice and will not be permitted anywhere prior to, with in or after the parade and any entry using handouts will be REMOVED FROM THE PARADE in the interest of safety.

Only one food drive pick-up will be permitted.

DO NOT INCLUDE A LIVE SANTA ON YOUR FLOAT.

Each entry in the parade will be limited to one (1) mobile unit.

Each Entry in the parade will be limited to one (1) person every two (2) feet of trailer length per float (i.e. 50 foot float =25 people). The committee will only accept a maximum of 25 people per float.

No one may get on or off a float once it has started on the parade route.

No Sounding of sirens or truck horns during the parade.

All mobile Entries are to have a FIRE EXTINGUISHER.

Late entries arriving may be rejected.

All participants from your group should know the entry Name (on Application), Number and a meeting place following the Parade (i.e. Canadian Tire Parking lot), prior to arriving at the marshalling grounds.

**PARADE DAY TIMING**

3:00 – 4:00	Mobile Units Line up.
4:00 – 5:30	Participants on floats and Marching Units Arrive
5:30	All units move forward to close any gaps (You should not have to be told to move forward)
5:55	Parade starts to move.
